4.1 OPERATIONS AND PUBLIC WORKS:

- 4.1.1 Municipal Building Work on the Municipal Building started May 22, 2017.
- 4.1.2 Artesian Wells The Town of Steady Brook received a letter from Municipal Affairs stating that any legal fees associated with the Artesian Wells will not be covered 90/10 and that the town will have to pay the full cost. The Town has still to release the holdback fees to Pittman Enterprises, this will be done once the Town's lawyer does a mechanic lien search stating that there are no outstanding vendors to be paid by Pittman Enterprises and as soon as the engineering firm (Anderson Engineering) and Municipal Affairs give the town the ok to release the funds. Once the funds are released the engineering firm will contact Pittman Enterprises to come and do the troubleshooting that is required on the Artesian Wells, hopefully the issues the town is experiencing with the water wells will be under warranty, if not under warranty the town will have to pay for Pittman Enterprises

cost occurred with retuning to the site. Councillor Wells stated that he would make a visit to the Engineering firm to follow up on the status of the Artesian Wells.

- 4.1.3 - True Lines - Quote for \$1925.00 plus tax. Council stated that going forward that a motion will not be required every year providing that the quote stays below the \$2000.00 threshold and that the Town Clerk/Manager can engage in a contractor under the above statement made by council.
